



Information for Virtual Lectures & Workshops
Prices in USD (Canadian prices available on request)

Lecture: \$450 / limited to 100 attendees unless on the guild's account: 1-hour presentation which includes live interactive question and answer period.

Workshops:

One-day Workshop Option: \$600 (Max. 20 students)

6 hours live with instructor via Zoom (can be split into two 3-hr days), including 48 hrs. access to all pre-recorded online video tutorials and printed materials (patterns, etc.)

Teacher/Student Contact Time: 6 hours

Access to Videos: 48 hours

Half-day Workshop Option: \$450 (Max. 20 students)

3 hours live via Zoom, including 48 hrs. access to the online tutorials and materials

Teacher/Student Contact Time: 3 hours

Access to Videos: 48 hours

Weeklong Workshop Option: \$600 (Max. 20 students)

3 hrs. live via Zoom+ 1 hr. Show & Tell

includes 7-day access to online tutorials, which students can work through at their own pace over the week, three 1-hr. meetings on the first day (orientation, mid-day check-up and end-of-day follow-up), a week of email support, plus follow-up 1-hr live Zoom Show & Tell and Q&A session at the end of the week

Teacher/Student Contact Time: 4 hours

Access to Videos: 7 days

Independent Payment Option: No cost to Guild (no maximum)

Guilds may elect to have ten or more members register individually (so no cost to the guild) to one common workshop on **CourseCraft**. On the day of the workshop, I meet with the students on Zoom for an orientation, start them off, and check in with them mid-morning and at the end of the day for wrap-up and Show & Share. Students now each own the course and can go back and watch videos over and over at their leisure.

For this option, the guild just needs to let Mary know which students will be purchasing the course so she can communicate with them by email in advance of the class to be sure they have all the supplies they will need.

Teacher/Student Contact Time: 3 hours

Access to Videos: one year

Unless otherwise arranged, Presenter will establish secure video conferencing technology (e.g. Zoom). Presentations (lectures and workshops) will include both live and pre-recorded segments to provide participants interactive attention and high-quality instruction. When applicable, supplemental materials will be presented via downloadable pdf files.

The video conferencing invitation link will be provided no later than 7 days prior to presentation.

Unauthorized sharing of log-in information is one way for cybercriminals to gain access and disrupt Zoom presentations. Links should only be shared with registered participants and never posted on public or unsecure websites or social media platforms.

Participants should consider having the most current versions of Zoom and virus protection software. Presenter is not responsible for hacked presentations.

Presenter maintains all rights and ownership of all content and recordings. Participants may not record or photograph, by any means, any portion of the presentation.

In the event of technical difficulties due to weather, power outages, equipment failure, etc., every effort will be made to reschedule the presentation as soon as possible, at a mutually agreeable time.
